### **MEMBER CATEGORIES**

**Full Members** have a demonstrated interest and active engagement in practice, research, teaching, administration, and/or study in the field of Clinical Psychology with training appropriate to the conduct of such clinical activities. They must also be full members of the APA. Full members may vote on any SCP nominations ballot. Membership also includes subscription to the journal, *Clinical Psychology: Science and Practice*.

**Early Career Psychologist (ECP) Members** are in the first four years after postdoctoral study who will learn more about activities and issues of interest to clinical psychologists, including reviewing for journals, mentoring, and much more. Membership includes online subscriptions to the SCP journal and newsletter. ECP members may attend the Society's meetings and participate in APA Convention events geared toward early-career psychologists. They may also join the SCP Listserv, exclusively for SCP members.

**Affiliate Members** are those who may or may not be members of the APA and may not have received a clinical degree, but who have demonstrated interest in and active engagement in practice, research, teaching, administration, and/or study in the field of Clinical Psychology. Affiliate membership does not include voting on SCP nomination ballots.

**Student Members** are undergraduate, graduate, and postdoctoral students who will learn more about activities and issues of interest to clinical psychologists. Membership benefits include: affirming your future identity as a clinical psychologist, opportunities to support advocacy for the integration of science and practice, opportunities for networking and leadership in a professional society, as well as the mentorship and student awards programs, and electronic access to the journal, *Clinical Psychology: Science and Practice*. Student members may attend the Society's meetings, without vote, and participate in SCP APA Convention events. They may also join the SCP Listserv, exclusively for SCP members.

Postdoctoral trainees and fellows many continue student membership for one year at \$25. After that year, you may become an Early Career Psychologist at \$40/year for up to four years after the postdoctoral year.

**Please Note** APA Early Career Psychologist (ECP) and student memberships are separate from the Society's. While APA membership is recommended, the Society does not require student or ECP members to be APA members.
